William Byrd Community House maintains a food closet that serves Richmond City and the adjacent counties. Clients can access our services by coming in during our Emergency Services Intake hours. We see clients three days a week on a walk-in basis.

When available, our food pantry also provides individuals with the basic household items and toiletries to maintain themselves and their families. These are everyday items that Food Stamp dollars will not cover and may be very costly to a low-income family.
